Who: St. Louis (PJ and non-PJ) folks with kids.

What: Collaboration with modern-orthodox synagogue, Bais Abraham (www.baisabe.com) during Purim Katan.

Program: Since there are two months of Adar this year, we decided to celebrate Purim Katan/Little Purim. We invited folks to come dress up and experience a Kabbalat **Shabbat on a Friday night in February....
