## PJ Our Way Around the House Scavenger Hunt:

The goal of the scavenger hunt is to collect as many objects as possible on the list and bring them back to the group within an eleven-minute timespan. Once the game is over, everyone should grab lunch or a snack and gather together in their virtual space. Participants can then choose one object they found that has meaning for them and share it with others.

## Rules of the game for the host family/host tween:

- Invite your friends. You need at least two, but no more than 5 other Jewish families to qualify.
- As the organizer, set up your virtual platform (Zoom, Skype, Google Hangouts, etc.) and share the link with your friends.
- Don't share the Scavenger Hunt list (below) until it's time to play. You can put it in the chat or email to your friends.
- Tell everyone that they have eleven minutes to run and find the items and bring them back to the screen.
- Once you are ready, share the list and set the timer!
- Every item found means a point for that team. A team can exist of one or more people.
- The winning team is the one with the most points.
- Celebrate with something delicious!
- Build in time for schmoozing while eating. Invite each participant to pick one thing to share in more detail with the group.

## Rules of the game for the host family/host tween:

- **1.** A toy from childhood
- 2. A favorite PJ Library or PJ Our Way book
- Something that connects you to a Jewish memory
- 4. A food you love
- 5. A present you got
- 6. A smell you like

- **7.** A family photo (if it is on your phone, that counts)
- 8. Something that you collect
- 9. Something made with your very own hands
- **10.** An animal (real, stuffed, or illustrated)
- **11.** A favorite piece of clothing
