Our Impact

PJ Library is a trusted parenting resource

Eighty-two percent of subscriber parents use PJ Library books to introduce Jewish topics. Nearly two-thirds (62%), rely on PJ Library books for quality family time.



PJ Library is a confidence builder

More than half (58%) of subscriber parents say PJ Library increased their confidence to engage their children in Jewish traditions, values, and customs; 70% of multifaith families say the same.



PJ Library helps families learn

Seventy percent of subscriber parents say PJ Library increased their children's knowledge or familiarity with Jewish traditions, values, and customs; approaching half (43%) of parents say PJ Library helped increase their own Jewish knowledge.
